As vaccine for COVID-19 rolls out in limited supply, vaccinations will initially be available for the following groups; Paid an unpaid persons serving in healthcare settings who have potential for direct or indirect exposure to patients or infectious materials

Tier 1A

Hospitals
Long-term Care Facilities
Outpatient Clinics
Home Health Care
Pharmacies
Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
Public Health

Within the above groups, these subgroups have been prioritized



- Priority 1
 - Hospitals emergency services personnel, public health employees providing vaccinations, private medical transportation providers
- Priority 2
 - Nursing homes and long-term care facilities staff and residents; Coroner/morgue
 Staff
- Priority 3
 - Other In-patient settings such as rehab and hospice facilities
- Priority 4
 - Healthcare staff and residents in other congregate settings, such as independent living and residential care facilities; group homes; prison medical staff.
- Priority 5
 - Home health care providers
- Priority 6
 - Out-Patient healthcare settings, such as urgent care and dialysis centers; public health clinics; dental services.
- Priority 7
 - Other Out-Patient Settings not already vaccinated during Priority 7.
